

## Tait Farm Harvest Shop in Centre Hall, Pennsylvania

Sawn at the Garland Mill in northern New Hampshire and notched and raised in the shadow of Nittany Mountain in central Pennsylvania, this timberframe is special to us for a multitude of reasons. The building is home to the Harvest Shop at **Tait Farm** – a grower, producer and purveyor of first-rate organic foodstuffs. The structure was designed by Harry Southworth, co-founder of Garland Mill Timberframes for his life-long best pal David Tait, founder of Tait Farm Foods.



The timberframe was raised by Harry along with local friends and community members in David's presence, although he was wheelchair-bound and bravely fighting cancer at the time. It is a thriving testament to two very fine men.
